Call to Order

Mayor Charlene Klein called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

Roll Call

Approval of the June 14, 2023 Parking Ad Hoc Committee minutes as prepared and distributed

Motion by Ames to approve, second by Pisano. No discussion. Motion carried 5-0.

Discussion/Recommendation regarding Parking Lot I Reserved parking

Elder stated Lot I all day parking reservations are now available through ParkMobile . Elder explained the process of reserving a parking space for a future date. Elder advised that a link will be added to the city website that will allow an additional option for consumers to reserve parking. The Mayor noted that she has shared reserved parking information with the local radio station along with Business Improvement District (BID) Executive Director Alex Binanti, in an effort to increase awareness of the all-day reservation option.

Discussion then focused on delays in all-day reserved parking implementation due to ParkMobile set up.

Discussion/Recommendation regarding 4th of July Weekend/Week Data

Elder provided a summation of the data included on page two of the packet, stating 2023 data showed a 1.5% increase in parking revenue as compared to 2022.
