Director's Report

Gajewski reviewed the submitted Directors Report. Discussion was had regarding DNR approval timelines with regard to the Big Foot Lift Station project. Discussion was also had on PFAS and the historical use of sailboat plaza before it was a park. Gajewski stated that the closest well in proximity to sailboat plaza had a no detect sample result in the initial round of PFAS testing.

Presentation of 2023 Lake Geneva Utility Commission Annual Financial Report and Management Letter by Lauterbach & Amen, LLP

Krisztina Dommer of Lauterbach & Amen, LLP, presented the Utility Commission's 2023 Annual Financial Report & Management Letter. She explained that the funds in the reports are included in the City's financial statements as well. The Utility's presentation only includes the water utility and sewer utility funds. Dommer said the audit process was smooth and they gave an unmodified audit opinion, which is what we should be hoping for.

Discussion/Action on a proposal from Lexipol to draft policy and procedural manuals for the Utility

Gajewski explained that the city has recently updated and consolidated their policy and procedures manuals. The Utility Commission has historically had its own set of policies and procedures and so Gajewski feels now would be the time to update ours as well. The quoted amount from Lexipol includes the initial work compiling the manuals, and also an annual review and update of any required federal/legal changes. This work was not included in the 2024 budget, which is why it is

being brought to the Commission now and the cost can be covered from general funds. Discussion was had on whether our current policies are in digital format or not and also on who the policies would apply to. The estimated time to start the project is two weeks. Howell/Binn motion to proceed with drafting the policy and procedures manual with Lexipol as proposed. Passed 5-0.

OPERATIONS UPDATE

WATER OPERATIONS

Staff continues to update and input data into the GIS site for the upcoming service line inventory deadline for the Revised Lead and Copper Rule.

Staff coordinated with DPW in several locations within the 2024 paving project to abandon several older and deteriorated valve pits to install our current standard of road boxes prior to paving.

Replacement of a lead service was completed on Wheeler St., which included the private side replacement in coordination with the Utility's work.

We're in the early stages of planning for the installation of the standby generator that was approved and delivered earlier this year. This work is anticipated to be completed near the end of October.

WASTEWATER OPERATIONS

Staff continued working with Engineering for the Big Foot Lift Station project, which is noticed on the August agenda for the potential award of the project. Additional project updates are provided in the Background Information portion of this report.

The sanitary lift station for Phase 5 of Symphony Bay successfully completed the start up process and we anticipate the last of the telemetry equipment to be installed by the end of August.

The 2024 CCTV project has transitioned to the televising portion of work, which is anticipated to wrap up within the next week.

The exterior building paint and headwork paint projects that were awarded in June have been completed and will be closed out upon approval of the final invoice payment.

OFFICE & ADMINISTRATION

The utility improvements for Phase 7 of Symphony Bay are scheduled to start in August and continue for approximately 2 months. A final walk-through of Phase 5 is planned for late August where final punchlist items will be addressed before the public improvements move toward the dedication process.

The upcoming 2025 budget process is scheduled to move forward similarly to prior years, with a preliminary draft of capital projects being presented at the September meeting, the draft O&M budget presented at the October meeting, and the final draft ready for potential adoption at the November meeting.

AUGUST 2024 UTILITY COMMISSION AGENDA - BACKGROUND INFORMATION

9. Big Foot Lift Station Force Main Replacement Project

This project was advertised for bidding, with an original bid opening date of 8/13/24. An addendum was issued to ultimately push the bid opening back to 8/19/24 and to adjust project milestones back by approximately one month, in response to feedback provided by Contractors aware of the project. The addenda were issued in the hope of securing the interest of multiple potential bidders, given the concerns raised about the project timelines as they relate to the weather delays that most companies have experienced this season.

As a result, Staff and Engineering do not have a summary or recommended action available as of the drafting of this report. However, the bid tabulation will be issued to the Commission as soon as possible on Monday, along with a recommendation for an award. Copies of the information will also be provided at the meeting.

A formal recommendation will be provided to the Commission at the August meeting.

10. Surveying & Engineering – White River Culvert Replacement

The Utility has historically used a former service road of Hillmoor Golf Course which begins on Haskins St. and allows access to Wellhouse 5, the associated transmission main to the Water Treatment Plant, as well as the East Interceptor Sewer that runs to the Wastewater Treatment Plant.

Part of the access drive includes 4 – 48” culverts that provide a crossing over the White River. These culverts have been in deteriorating condition for some time, and during recent rains, a significant washout occurred on the upstream side of the culverts.

In response, the Utility and DPW staff contacted two engineering firms to discuss the potential replacement of the culverts and the processes necessary to complete the permitting and design work ahead of construction.

Copies of two proposals have been included in the meeting packet for Commission review. The scope of services would push the project toward bidding on the eventual replacement of the structures, and Staff would return for the hopeful award of the work after the bidding process is completed. This project was not anticipated as part of the 2024 budgetary process, and Staff would recommend that the professional services be funded from the respective Capital Project Funds, split 60/40 between the Water Utility and Wastewater Utility.

Action is recommended to approve the proposals from Ellena Engineering Consultants and Kapur & Associated for surveying and engineering services necessary to replace culverts along the Well 5 access road.

11. Vehicle & Equipment Tracking Services

Over the past several months, Staff has been working with representatives of Verizon to prepare a scope of services that includes the supplying of equipment and its installation as well as a monitoring platform for vehicle and asset tracking services of the Utility fleet.

While the total cost is well below Staff's approval authority, the subscription services are provided for a 12-month period, which inherently would affect the yet-to-be-approved 2025 Utility budget. As such, Staff is requesting the Commission to provide direction on this item.

Action is recommended to approve the proposal from Verizon Connect for vehicle and asset tracking subscriptions.

12. Closed Session – Ground Lease Request - VB 500 II, LLC

Staff will be in attendance at the meeting and will participate in the closed session at the direction of the Commission to provide additional information on the noticed item.









TASK ORDER NUMBER #36

CIVIL ENGINEERING SERVICES

This task order is made as of August 7, 2024 under the terms and conditions established in the MASTER AGREEMENT FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES, (the Agreement), between the **City of Lake Geneva (Owner)** and **Kapur (Engineer)**. This Task Order is made for the following purpose:

WETLAND DELINEATION & STRUCTURE/TOPOGRAPHIC SURVEY

Wetlands are regulated under the US Environmental Protection Agency Clean Water Act and jurisdictional authority of wetlands rests with the US Army Corps of Engineers. In addition, the WDNR and local municipalities have regulatory authority over wetlands. Kapur has completed a wetland reconnaissance and has determined that a wetland delineation is required for review and concurrence for establishment of the wetland protective areas by the US ACOE and DNR. As required by WDNR/ACOE Wetland Guidance, Kapur will also visually assess a 75'-offset area from the proposed project site locations.

The access road culverts located to the Southeast of Haskins Street and south of the Wastewater Treatment Facility are in need of replacement. Kapur has been requested to provide structure and topographic survey consistent with FEMA and DNR hydraulic modeling requirements. The vertical elevations will be recorded in NGVD 29 to match the FEMA regulatory model datum.

Section A. – Scope of Services

Engineer shall perform the following Services:

WETLAND DELINEATION

The wetland delineation process is based on the *1987 Corps of Engineering Wetland Delineation Manual* and is comprised of three steps 1) an off-site review of maps and aerial imagery including the WDNR Wisconsin Wetland Inventory and Wetland Indicator maps and aerial photographs, 2) an on-site field investigation for wetlands and composition of a wetland delineation report and 3) submitting the report to the WDNR, applying for concurrence, and meeting the DNR on-site for concurrence.

During the on-site investigation, potential wetland areas are tested based on three parameters: hydrology, hydric soils, and hydrophytic vegetation. All areas testing positive in those three areas are legally defined as wetland and flagged.

- The wetland delineations will be conducted by WDNR Assured Wetland Delineator, Dave Meyer from Wetland and Waterway Consulting, LLC.
- Assured Delineator will flag the wetland boundaries.
- Kapur will survey the flags and import the survey data to create the wetland delineation exhibit and provide the wetland delineation figure and coordination for report completion.



The scope and fees are determined based upon our understanding of the project as described in this proposal. Expansion or changes to the scope of work, performance time, or unanticipated site conditions may require a contract amendment.

STRUCTURE AND TOPOGRAPHIC SURVEY

Perform survey of existing structures including size, upstream and downstream invert, materials, embankment geometry, and roadway crossing for 25-ft along drive either side beyond structure, and other hydraulic characteristics.

- A topographic survey will be performed at the structure and at upstream/downstream bounding cross-section as determined by engineer. The survey will record the channel geometry, top of banks, and span the 100-year floodplain limits. Structure survey data will be provided to engineer.
- Survey data will be uploaded into AutoCAD 3D and provided to the engineer as a point file. No preparation of exhibits or construction plans are anticipated.
- Kapur will provide site control and bench marks for future construction work.

Kapur will locate and detail all visible site improvements within the indicated area on the attached map, including but not limited to, major vegetation, culvert structures, utilities, cross sections, and wetland delineation areas. Individual tree locations are included, although large groups of trees will be field located to the edge of major tree lines. Below ground utilities will be field surveyed based on Digger's Hotline field locations. If applicable, Manholes will be located, and depths will be measured if confined space entry is not required. If a confined space crew is required, it will be completed on a time and material basis. Kapur will require any existing plans from the owner that will aid in locating existing utilities. Kapur will collect ground elevations over the balance of the site.

This proposal is for a topographic survey only and does not include easements, platting, boundary, or construction layout work. These services can be provided at an additional fee. A current title policy will need to be provided by the Owner.

Section B. – Schedule

Engineer shall perform the Scope of Services and deliver the related Documents according to the following tentative schedule:

Survey data provided to engineer with Wetland Delineation and report completion by August 30th, 2024.

Section C. – Compensation





In return for the performance of the foregoing obligations, Owner shall pay to Engineer an amount not-to-exceed Five Thousand and Seven Hundred Dollars (\$5700), payable according to the following terms:

A not-to-exceed amount based on the rates as listed in Attachment A of the Agreement, plus direct expenses. Cost plus services are limited to an agreed maximum figure unless amended.

Engineer may request a change to the billing hours if scope changes, beyond the control of the Engineer, resulting in an extension of the schedule or necessitates a change in personnel.

Compensation for Additional Services (if any) shall be paid by Owner to Engineer according to the hourly billing rates shown in Attachment A of the Agreement.
