- 3. INTRODUCTION BARTLETT TREES-**Mark Mozuch a certified arborist based out of Lake Geneva with bartlett trees. Would like to be involved with the community through the tree board.

Dennis- Has issue with too many trees cut down and not being treated with chemical first. For spruce trees with needle cast.

- 6. ARBORIST REPORT-**
Been in contact with Mike Mundy in stone ridge, and in contact with symphony bay on replanting and resetting trees that were planted improperly. Trees planted too deep will be stressed, stunted and end up with girdling roots.
The crew is trimming trees and removing dead wood also will be doing some inventory of the cemetery trees.
Injections with R10 in Oaks at the cemeteries was done in June because of two-line chestnut borer which kills the oaks from the top down.
