**ADJORNMENT**- Candy makes motion Sonya Seconds unanimously approved.



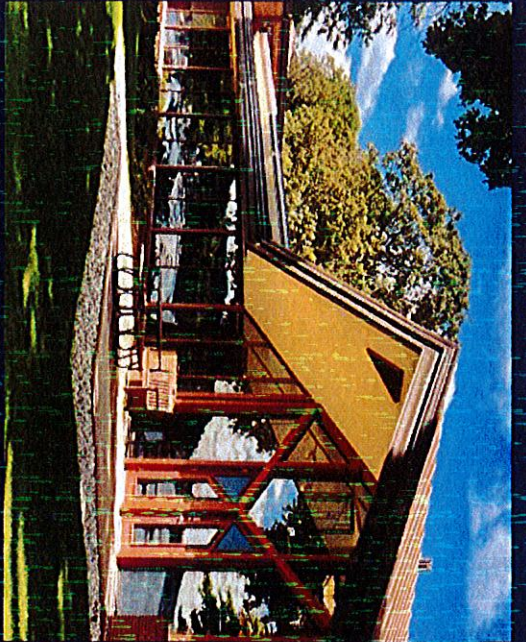
